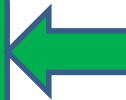

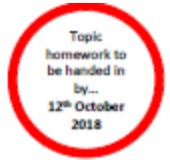

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Topic Homework - Must do's

Tic-tac-toe - You must complete three squares in a row, passing vertically, horizontally or diagonally through the Golden Square.

<p>Research and draw a uniform for a WW2 soldier or nurse.</p>	<p>Create a 3D model relating to an aspect of the war.</p>	<p>Listen to the music from the War of the Worlds and compose a poem relating to how the music made you feel.</p>
<p>Research food that was rationed during the war and write your own recipe. If you can, make it (take photos).</p>	<p>Research at least 3 elements of life during WW2 (e.g. diet, lifestyle, evacuees, jobs). Present your findings in a creative way e.g. record a news report, write a newspaper article, leaflet, PowerPoint etc.</p>	<p>Make a word search containing as many words relating to the topic as possible. Challenge a family member or friend to solve it.</p>
<p>Make a collage of a historic battle scene.</p>	<p>Create a mathematical code cracker for the topic.</p>	<p>Read a book that has a link/theme of battle/war. Write a book review to share with the class.</p>

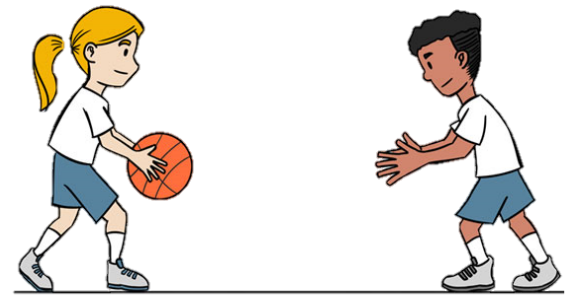
PE and Sports

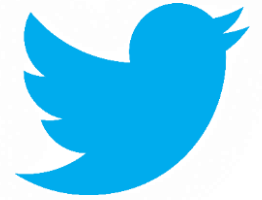
