Dear Parents/ carers,

I hope you are all staying well and safe. School isn't the same anymore with some of the children working at home: although we have a third of the children still coming in every day, I hardly get to see any of them so it really is strange for all of us.

Thank you as always for all of your support, positive emails and goodies for the staff room. It really does keep us all going through this difficult period. Having met with the Headteachers from local schools virtually earlier this week, it was a relief to hear that school staff everywhere are finding this tough! So honestly your kind words really do give us the lift we need. Running 2 schools is not an easy task, especially with the raised (and ever-changing!) expectations placed upon us from the Government but I am extremely proud that we have been able to offer such fantastic home learning as well as for those who are still learning in school. It sounds like the live lessons have been successful for most of you – I'm just glad it's Mrs Farage and the teachers managing the technology and not me! I'm in my comfort zone working in school every day!

As you know, we had our first positive case of COVID-19 in school earlier this week. This was managed quickly and well to minimum risk to wider contacts so only 13 children have had to self-isolate. As with anything like, this, we always use things like this as an opportunity to review all of our risk assessments and arrangements and those children in school will now only be socialising at break and lunchtime with their own bubbles. This is to minimise potential further disruption if we are to get another case.

Can I please ask that if any of your children do test positive for COVID-19, you inform us as soon as possible via the email address shared previously: covid@frimley.surrey.sch.uk. This applies to all families, even if home learning or self-isolating. We really do want to be kept informed and remain connected with all our families and would need to know in order to be able to support the child and the whole family ie whether your child still needs work sending home/whether they will still be registering daily if at home/whether your family need support from us etc. Just because you might be learning at home, you are still very much part of our Frimley family!
