


Dear parents and carers,

We have recently signed up for a trial with Purple Mash by 2Simple. It is a comprehensive and safe learning platform which can be accessed via any device whilst the children are learning remotely at home. After half term, we will be setting the children some computing tasks to complete through Purple Mash so that they gain some basic computing knowledge and experience prior to returning to school.

We have allocated each of the children login details which they will need to access the website. These will be the same as their TT Rockstars username and password which the children should know or have stuck within their diaries. If they are unsure of these, please get in contact with their class teacher via [info@frimley.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@frimley.surrey.sch.uk) to request these details.

It is recommended that you log in with your child for the first time and then allow them the opportunity to spend some time exploring the site. To access the website use <https://www.purplemash.com/sch/frimley>

When they log in they will have access to different subjects and topics through the Tools section, be able to practice different skills through the Games section and access a variety of online books through the Serial Mash section. They will not need to access Mini Mash as it is aimed at 3 to 5 year olds.



After half term, the children may have work set for them to complete. This will show as an alert in the 2dos section in the top left corner of the homepage page. They will get a description of the task which has been set and the opportunity to complete it and hand it in for their teacher to see.

The site offers other facilities too such as a blog, share boards and email but we will only be using it to support the children's learning through the above sections.
